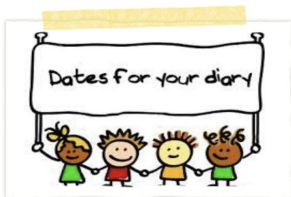

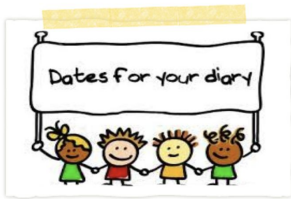

We will be carrying out our Education Outside the Classroom in week 3.
